Other Details

All curlers must stay at the designated St. Norbert College dorm. Adult counselors will monitor dorm rooms. Curling will take place at the Green Bay Curling Club. For curlers who drive: car keys must be turned in upon arrival. *Your need for extra money will be minimal, however, you are advised to bring cash or a cash card for spending or in case of emergency.* Do not bring anything of great value (camp officials are not responsible for lost or stolen items). Camp check-in will be at 1:00 pm on Friday at St. Norbert's College and checkout will be on Sunday at 3:00 pm at the Green Bay Curling Club.
